Last year, Mowbray Primary School was awarded the 'Unicef UK Rights Respecting Schools' bronze award. Children continue to learn about their rights in school and practice supporting others to learn about and uphold their rights. Our aim is to be a school where children's rights are at the heart of our ethos and culture, by improving well-being and developing every child's talent and ability to reach their full potential. As part of this plan, we are working towards gaining silver recognition.

As we move forward with children's rights at the forefront of our vision, I am running a competition for children to design a Mowbray Rights Respecting Mascot. The mascot can be a person, animal, monster or any character you wish. If your child would like to enter the competition then they need to draw a picture of their mascot and think of a name for the character.
